



CALCIFIED SEAWEED

INTRODUCTION

- ◆ A soil improver, Calcified Seaweed is rich in calcium magnesium and trace elements. It is produced naturally from marine sources, but has been calcified (turned to lime).
- ◆ Ideal as a soil conditioner and clay breaker.
- ◆ Use it on lawns, beds and borders to correct soil acidity.
- ◆ Helps break down heavy soils and encourages beneficial soil micro-organisms.
- ◆ Calcified Seaweed improves soil structure which in turn helps plants to develop stronger roots, promoting healthier and more vigorous plant growth.
- ◆ Highly favoured by chrysanthemum, sweet pea, dahlia, leek and onion growers.

APPLICATION

- ◆ Apply at the rate of 75 grams per square metre (2.5 ounces per square yard).
- ◆ Should be watered in if no rain within 24 hours of application.
- ◆ To soil – one application every three years. Lightly hoe or rake in.
- ◆ To lawns – dress in early spring.

CAUTION

- ◆ Do NOT use with ericaceous acid-loving plants.
- ◆ Store in a dry, frost-free place away from children, pets and foodstuff.
- ◆ Wash hands and exposed skin after use.
- ◆ Wear gloves when handling.
