# DRIED BLOOD

# 12% Nitrogen

#### INTRODUCTION

Dried Blood is an organic source of nitrogen to improve foliar growth. It is useful for feeding leafy plants such as salads and vegetables like brassicas. Also an excellent feed for foliage plants.

#### **HOW TO USE**

- ◆ Scatter 35 grams per square metre (1 ounce per square yard) evenly over the area as a top dressing near the growing crop and lightly hoe in.
- ◆ Apply at monthly intervals for strong growing leafy vegetables such as brassicas.
- ◆ Apply frequently to 'cut and come again' salad leaves to keep them cropping all season.

## APPLICATION ADVICE

- Use the recommended amount.
- ◆ Apply evenly between the plants, without touching the plant itself.
- Avoid using on windy days.
- Water well in after applying.
- Wash hands after use.

### **STORAGE**

Store in a cool, dry place away from children, pets and foodstuffs.
