INTRODUCTION

Hoof and Horn organic fertilizer is a source of nitrogen (13%) for garden plants, especially high feeders like tomatoes and corn, and plants that make large amounts of green leaf, such as brassicas (e.g. cabbage and kale), lettuces, courgettes and rhubarb.

This organic fertilizer is made from cooked ground dehydrated cattle hooves and horns obtained from slaughterhouses.

Hoof and Horn is similar to Dried Blood in nitrogen content, but the nutrient availability is slower, which is better for organic crops and with less “leaf burn” damage. Its nutrient availability starts at around 4 to 6 weeks and can last 12 months.

APPLICATION RATE

140 grams per square metre (5 oz per square yard) at the start of the season, and 30 grams per square metre (1 oz per square yard) when transplanting vegetables.

USAGE

- Use to increase green leaf growth.
- Use to increase root growth.
- Use instead of manure with rhubarb.
- Improves soil structure.
- Nutrient availability is slower than Dried Blood and is a better choice.
- When adding to your garden as a nitrogen source, always blend it into the soil.
- Can be used as a compost decomposition activator.
