



# NITRATE OF CHALK

## (Calcium Ammonium Nitrate)

27 – 0 – 0

Nitrate of Chalk is a quick-acting fertilizer most frequently used in spring or early summer before planting or during the early days of growth. It is especially useful for brassicas.

Nitrate of Chalk is a synthetically-produced fertilizer consisting of ammonium nitrate and chalk, the former constituent being very soluble in water. Half of its content of nitrogen is in the form of nitrate, and is therefore immediately available. The other half is in the form of ammonia which, although readily available, comes into action slightly later, thus giving the fertilizer a more sustained action than nitrate of soda.

### APPLICATION

Apply at the rate of 50 grams per square metre (1½ ounces per square yard).

### CAUTION

- ◆ Do not mix with other fertilizers.
- ◆ Store in a dry, frost-free place away from children, pets and foodstuff.
- ◆ Wash hands and exposed skin after use.
- ◆ Wear gloves when handling.
