



POTATO PLANTER BAG

Grow Potatoes Anywhere –
even if you don't have a garden



These high-quality, reusable potato planter bags are ideal for the keen gardener who is short on space or who wants to grow potatoes out of season on their patio or other suitable places.

You can grow bumper crops of potatoes in these handy 45-litre potato planters, and simply pick your crop as and when you need them.

Height: 48 cm (18"). Capacity: 45 litres.

Potato Layering – the Planter Bag way

The most effective method of planting seed potatoes in a planter bag. Layers give you a higher yield than any other method.

Step 1

Place your first two seed potatoes on about 10 cm (4 inches) of compost at the bottom of your planter bag, in a North-South direction.

Cover with a further 10 cm (4 inch) layer of compost.



Step 2

Place another two seed potatoes on top of this layer, in an East-West direction.

Cover with another 10 cm (4 inch) layer of compost.



Step 3

As shaws begin to appear, continue to cover in fresh compost until the soil is up to 5 cm (2 inches) from the top of the bag.

This will ensure the maximum possible room for your tubers to grow.



Step 4

Keep away from cold temperatures and water periodically.

Tubers can be ready to harvest in as little as ten weeks, but can be left to grow until the shaws begin to die off.
