



# SULPHATE OF AMMONIA

Sulphate of Ammonia is a rapid source of nitrogen for growing plants. Green-leaved vegetables, such as cabbages and lettuces, respond particularly well to the extra nitrogen.

## General Plant Feeding

- Scatter 35 grams per square metre (1 oz per square yard) around the plants.
- Lightly fork or hoe in.
- Repeat once or twice through the growing season.

## Preparing Beds and Borders

- Scatter 35 grams per square metre (1 oz per square yard) evenly over the area.
- Lightly fork or hoe in.

## Application Advice

- Use the recommended amount.
- Apply evenly between the plants, without touching the plant itself.
- Avoid using on windy days.
- Water well in after applying.
- Wash hands after use.

## Storage

Store in a cool, dry place away from children, pets and foodstuffs.
