SULPHATE OF POTASH

Sulphate of Potash replenishes potassium levels in soil. It encourages firm vegetative growth, increases resistance to disease and improves flower and fruit quality. Use it round fruit bushes and trees to encourage better and larger fruits.

HOW TO USE

- Scatter 35 gm per square metre (1 oz per square yard) evenly around the plants.
- Some more greedy fruits, such as raspberries, gooseberries and currants can be given up to 70 gm per square metre (2 oz per square yard).
- Lightly fork or hoe in.
- Repeat once or twice through the growing season.
- Sandy and light soils will need top dressing more frequently, i.e. 3 or 4 times during the growing season.

APPLICATION ADVICE

- Use the recommended amount.
- Apply evenly between the plants, without touching the plant itself.
- Avoid using on windy days.
- Water well in after applying.
- Wash hands after use.

STORAGE

Store in a cool, dry place away from children, pets and foodstuffs.
