



SUPERPHOSPHATE OF LIME

Helps new plants establish strong roots

Superphosphate is a plant food that promotes root development.

An application when planting encourages stronger establishment and earlier maturity.

When and where to use

Preparing Beds, Borders and Vegetable Plots

- Scatter 20 to 35 gm per square metre (0.6 to 1 oz per square yard) evenly over the area.
- Fork well in.

General Plant Feeding

- Scatter 20 to 35 gm per square metre (0.6 to 1 oz per square yard) around the plants.
- Lightly fork or hoe in.
- Repeat each spring.

Application

- Apply evenly between the plants, without touching the plant stems.
- Use the recommended amount.
- Avoid using on windy days.
- Water well in after applying.
- Wash hands after use.

Storage

Store in a cool, dry place away from children, pets and foodstuffs.

Analysis

	Phosphorus Pentoxide (P ₂ O ₅)
Soluble in Neutral Ammonium Citrate	18.0% [Phosphorus (P) 7.8%]
Soluble in water	16.8% [Phosphorus (P) 7.3%]
