



# WEEDOL® ROOTKILL PLUS™ WEEDKILLER

LIQUID CONCENTRATE TUBE

## SYSTEMIC

**Weedol® Rootkill Plus™** is a systemic herbicide, killing all garden broad-leaved and grass weeds down to the roots so they won't grow back. One application is enough to kill all but the most stubborn garden weeds. Replant or sow soon after application.

## ACTS FAST

Results begin to be visible in just 23 hours.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

### FOR USE ONLY AS A HOME GARDEN WEEDKILLER

Read all Safety Instructions before use. For use on unwanted vegetation, areas not intended to bear vegetation and around garden plants.

**Maximum individual dose:** 25 ml product per 14 square metres.

## WHEN TO USE:

**Weedol® Rootkill Plus™** should be applied from April to November, when the weeds are actively growing. Apply on a dry day and do not apply in windy conditions. Re-treat if rain falls within 6 hours of application.

## WHERE TO USE:

**Weedol® Rootkill Plus™** can be used to control weeds on gravel areas, paths and drives, along fences, around sheds and greenhouses. Around the base of roses, ornamental shrubs, trees and under hedges (providing they are established, with woody bark). Take care to avoid drift!

**DO NOT USE ON LAWNS, UNLESS YOU WANT TO KILL THEM.**

**Weedol® Rootkill Plus™** is ideal for ground clearance before autumn or spring digging and killing old lawns before reseeding or turfing.

**1 tube (18 ml) treats up to 30 m<sup>2</sup>**

## HOW TO USE:

- 1 Use either: Watering can with a weedkiller sprinkle bar or a fine rose, or a garden sprayer.
- 2 Simply snap off (or cut open) the top of the tube and mix with 1 litre of water in a sprayer, or 5 litres of water in a watering can and mix thoroughly/
- 3 Apply the spray evenly to the weeds, to lightly wet the leaves. Allow spray to dry before walking or plying on treated areas.
- 4 25 ml treats:  
30 m<sup>2</sup> annual weeds  
20 m<sup>2</sup> perennial weeds  
14 m<sup>2</sup> brush weeds
- 5 Clean the equipment thoroughly before and after use. Do not use in galvanized or mild steel watering cans or sprayers.
- 6 Visible effects in 24 hours. Weed death may take up to 28 days (in cold weather, activity is slower).

## AMOUNT TO USE:

The amount of **Weedol® Rootkill Plus™** required depends on the **type of weeds to be treated** and **kind of equipment** used.

**Add one tube to: Sprayer: 1 litre water**

**Watering can: 5 litres water**

		Area treated	Examples
One tube treats:	Annual weeds	30 m <sup>2</sup>	Chickweed, Fat hen, Field speedwell, Shepherds purse, Field forget-me-not, Cleavers
	Perennial weeds	20 m <sup>2</sup>	Creeping thistle, Rosebay willowherb, Perennial nettle, Docks, Couch grass, Perennial ryegrass, Bindweed
	Brush weeds (Repeat application may be required after 28 days)	14 m <sup>2</sup>	Bramble, Bracken

Only make as much Weedol® Rootkill Plus™ as you intend to use that day

## CAUTION

**Weedol® Rootkill Plus™** kills all green plant growth including lawn grasses. DO NOT apply to lawns and plants if you want to keep them.

Avoid all contact of spray and spray drift with cultivated plants and desired vegetation.

Direct application away from ponds and other surface water bodies.

## TIPS

- REPLANTING AND SOWING: Where a **light covering of annual weeds** has been treated – area can be replanted 1 day after spraying.
- Where a **dense covering of annual and/or perennial weeds** has been treated – area can be replanted 7 days after spraying (to allow the weedkiller to move to the roots before cultivation).

## SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

### Protection during/in use

Keep children and pets away from treated areas until spray has dried

Do not contaminate water with the product or its tube.

Do not empty into drains.

### Storage and disposal

Dispose of empty tube in the dustbin.

Dispose of unused product in its tube at a household waste site (civic amenity site). Contact your local council (local authority) for details.
