A Compound Feed For Wild Birds

Introduction

Our Wild Bird Food is a superb wild bird food mixture, and contains a broad range of smaller seeds.

Composition/Ingredients

Wheat, Mixed Seeds, Maize Grits, Black Sunflowers, Yellow Millet, Red Millet, Red Dari, White Dari, Safflower and Vegetable Oil.

General Feeding and Care Guide

- Food should be made available throughout the year, including during breeding, nesting and fledging periods.
- Maintain a regular supply of fresh food, enough to last one or two days.
- Clean water should be made available at all times.
- Help weaker birds and more timid species by having several feeding stations and moving them regularly.
- Consider different foods and feeding methods, as although some birds can hang from feeders, others may prefer ground or table feeding.
- Feeding stations should be located near cover. If there is a risk from predators, such as cats, a greater distance or height should be allowed.
- Remove any wet or old food as soon as possible to avoid the build up of bacteria, moulds or toxins.
- Ensure feeding stations are regularly cleaned with warm water and ideally use a safe disinfectant.
- Food should be stored in a cool, dry place, free from pests and vermin.
- Wash your hands thoroughly after handling products.
